Zones of Interest



Cerro Barón and its surroundings

Take the elevator to the top and enjoy a panoramic view of the city. Explore the art and heritage of Cerro Barón and its proximity to the pier of the same name, ideal for water sports and recreation.

Cerro Playa Ancha

The largest hill in the city stands out for its heritage architecture and charming coastline. Stroll along Avenida Gran Bretaña and enjoy Las Torpederas beach, Paseo Altamirano and El Membrillo cove.

Cerro Alegre and Concepción

Both hills combine history and architecture in palaces, narrow streets such as Lautaro Rosas, and the Baburizza Museum. A walk where culture, art, and urban charm come together.

Cerro Bellavista-Florida

Walk down Héctor Calvo Street, visit Plaza Mena and Pablo Neruda's La Sebastiana House Museum. Bellavista and Florida offer themed hotels, colorful streets, and viewpoints with unique vistas.
